BEACH WHEELCHAIRS – FAQs FOR HIRERS

1. What beach wheelchairs are available?

There are five beach wheelchairs available. They are quite different in design. You need to decide which one will best suit your mobility needs. The Mobichair floats and can enter the sea.



2. How do I hire one?

You need to contact Lyme Regis Town Council Office on 01297 445175 or email us on enquiries@lymeregistowncouncil.gov.uk. We can then tell you whether a wheelchair is available on the day you want. If a wheelchair is available, we will take your details and email you a copy of the booking form and terms and conditions.

3 Is there a charge?

No. But all hirers will be held liable for any damages (as per the terms and conditions).

4 What are the hire conditions?

These can be found <u>here</u>. You will be asked to sign that you have read and understood them when you collect the wheelchair.

5 Where can I take them?

The wheelchairs must be taken only on the sand part of Front Beach and Marine Parade (the pedestrian area behind the beach) as necessary to access the beach. Additionally, the Mobichair (floating) wheelchair can enter the sea.

6. Where do I collect the wheelchair from?

From the Jubilee Pavilion in the middle of Marine Parade (the main seafront). The Seafront Attendant will be there and expecting you.

7. Can I hire without pre-booking?

If there are no bookings for the day, it might be possible for the town council to arrange a hire, but this cannot be guaranteed.
